We hope you find this information useful and that it may help you have a better understanding of what your children may tell you about their time in school.

English (Literacy) and Mathematics

In Literacy this term our learning will begin with a story 'Dinosaurs and all that rubbish' We will be writing setting descriptions from the story as well as writing a letter and a postcard. We will also be writing a recount based on our visit to Moorlands discovery.

We will be exploring a variety of stories including retelling stories, writing our own stories, instructions and finally a letter to Father Christmas.

In Numeracy we will look at numbers, number names, the value of numbers, counting, adding and subtracting, multiplication and division, fractions and shape.

Geography/History

In Geography we will be exploring the local area, identifying recycling points and using an atlas to locate the 7 continents and oceans of the world.

In history we will be learning about the history of paper in schools - What did people write on in the past? How will this change in the future?

We will also be learning about Christopher Columbus, Guy Fawkes, Diwali, Remembrance day and Christmas.

Science

In year 1 children will be learning about animals including humans. They will draw and label the basic parts of the human body, carry out an investigation using their 5 senses and identify and name common animals

This term in year 2 children will be learning about animals including humans. We will learn about animals and their off spring, how humans grow, what animals and humans need to survive and healthy eating.

We will carry out different investigations one of these being around exercise.

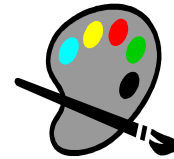
Information and Communications Technology (ICT)

This term children will learn to use the internet to carry out research, take photographs using a camera, use Microsoft word to create a leaflet and use Microsoft paint.

Design Technology

During this first half term we will be having a go at creating our own recycled paper. After half term your child will be looking at using recycled material to create musical instruments and Christmas decorations.

Art

In Art children will be learning about the work of Lowry We will create our own art work inspired by these artists.

Music

We will learn the dinosaur stomp and other dinosaur songs. Children will also have the opportunity to use a range of instruments.

We will then learn our Christmas Nativity songs for our performances on Monday 12th December (10.30am) and Tuesday 13th December (2.15pm).

Religious Education

In Religious Education we will learn about belonging to a community and the different ways in which people celebrate around the world.
