Real project

Year 5 will hold a performance evening at the Rotherham Civic in the new year where they will perform the play they have written. The children will audition for parts and can also become stage managers!

Geography

Comparing and locating cities and towns in the UK. The impact of market towns and changes in landscapes.

History

Asking questions and researching using a range of sources to understand the origins of the Tudor dynasty.

Physical Education

The children will develop their football and dance skills.



Personal, Social and Health Education (PSCHE)

During this term, the children will study a variety of themes to promote self-esteem and social awareness. These will be 'Me and My Relationships' and The Golden Rules.

We hope you find this information useful and that it may help you have a better understanding of what your children may tell you about their time in school.



English (Literacy)

This term we are focussing on character and setting descriptions, as well as storytelling. The children will explore the surroundings in Stratford-Upon Avon and learn about character feelings and motives.

Throughout the autumn term, the class book will be *The Twelfth Night*, in preparation for the children's performance in January 2019.

We will use this text to help us write our own play script.

We will further explore modern and traditional poetry too!

Mathematics

In maths, the children will be consolidating their previous knowledge and studying a range of mathematical concepts including:

- Place value
- Rounding and estimating larger numbers
- Money and real life problems (please encourage your children to help with the shopping!)
- Multiplication and the use of division to find simple fractions

- The impact of multiplying and dividing by 10 and 100

The children will be going outside for some of their maths learning and be reasoning within a mystery maths trail!

Science

The children will be following the topics of forces and materials. This will link to our STEM project of designing a prop for the play or a Tudor house!

Religious Education

What do Hindus' believe about God?
How do Hindus' celebrate life and death
What matters most in life?

Science

The children will learn about Christianity and different sacred books, for example, learning about the bible and understanding that Muslims have the Qur'an as their sacred text, and Jewish people have the Torah.

The Christian sacred book is the Bible.

Information and Communications Technology (ICT)


In ICT the children will be using a range of apps to create and present their writing. They will be using a range of ways to program information.
