### **English (Literacy) and Mathematics**

In Literacy this term our learning will begin with an explanation text linked to a science investigation to see which materials will react together to make a magic potion. We will then focus our literacy learning around 'Winnie the Witch and will be writing character and setting descriptions from the story. Following our visit to Magna we will be writing and creating our own set of instructions for a magic potion. We will end our learning on magic potions by creating our own poem.

We will be exploring a variety of stories including Hooray for Bread and we will look at different genres of writing including a recount and a newspaper report.

In Numeracy we will look at fractions, time, measurements, money, adding and subtracting, multiplication and division, position and direction and shape.

### **Geography/History**

In history we will be learning about the artist Roy Lichtenstein. Who he is? What he is famous for? During the second half term we will look at the history of bread - How it is made? - How it has changed over time? What are the uses of bread? - What are the different types of bread?

We will also be learning about Easter.

### **Science**

This term in children will be learning about everyday materials. We will learn about materials and the different uses, how different materials react, what materials are good for mopping up spillages, how things change when they are heated and looking into a scientist who created materials.

We will carry out different investigations one of these being around a magic potion.

After half term we will look at the human body and healthy eating.

### **Information and Communications Technology (ICT)**

This term children will learn to use Comicliffe, Purplemash, and the exciting opportunity to learn how to use our new iPads.

### **Design Technology**

During this term we will be looking at healthy and unhealthy foods. We will then look at healthy breakfasts. Then we will look at different toppings for toast, have the chance to taste them and finally design our own toast and toppings. Parents will then be invited to our very own Tasty Toast coffee morning.

It will be held on the 22<sup>nd</sup> March 2019.



### **Art**

In Art children will be learning about the work of Roy Lichtenstein. We will create our own art work inspired by these artists.

### **Music**

We will learn the song *In the Groove*. Children will also look at the beat and pulse. Children will listen and appraise different songs in the genre of music we are studying. They will have the opportunity to use a range of instruments.

### **Religious Education**

In year 1 we will learn about what festivals Jewish people like to celebrate and look at what happens in a church and a synagogue. In year 2 we will learn about what is believing and being fair. We will also look at the bible story *The Lost Sheep*.
